The purpose of this study was to determine the role of Dasa Wisma in shaping the character of social concerns of Dasa Wisma members in Gunung Pagat Hamlet, Loa Janan Ulu Village, Loa Janan District, Kutai Kartanegara Regency and to find out Dasa Wisma's efforts in shaping the social care character of Dasa Wisma members in Gunung Pagat Hamlet, Loa Janan Ulu Village, Loa Janan District, Kutai Kartanegara Regency. This type of research is descriptive qualitative. The techniques used in data collection in this study were observation, interviews, and documentation. The data analysis techniques used are data reduction, presentation (data display) and drawing conclusions. Based on the results of existing research and discussions, the author can conclude that the role of Dasa Wisma in shaping the character of social concerns of Dasa Wisma members in Gunung Pagat Hamlet, Loa Janan Ulu Village, is realized through the implementation of community data recording and reporting activities and citizen activities carried out by the Dasa Wisma group which has been running very well, data recorded such as recording and recording data on residents' activities. I. INTRODUCTION

Human beings are by nature social beings, who are always in relationships with each other, who cannot live alone and always need others to support their survival. Under such conditions, social care becomes important to get used to. In social life, people must respect each other, love and care for various kinds of surrounding circumstances. This concern is an attitude of paying attention to

something that does not intend to interfere in the affairs of others but rather helps solve problems with the aim of kindness so that a balance will be created.

In rural areas, the values of local wisdom, cooperation between communities is also fading, the lower the sense of community concern due to the negative impact of the rapid flow of globalization. Causes of the fading of these values

very diverse, among them due to social inequality or social status, due to the selfish attitude of each individual, the lack of understanding or cultivation of social caring values, the lack of tolerance, sympathy and empathy of society. Social concern will give rise to social attitudes, where social attitudes are individual consciousness that determines real actions to behave in a certain way towards others and attach importance to social goals rather than personal goals in community life, such as helping each other, respecting each other, interacting with each other, and so on. Social attitudes are needed to establish relationships with other people in daily life and can create an atmosphere of life that is peaceful, harmonious, comfortable, and peaceful.

In the process of nation development, women have a role that is no less important than men to actively contribute to development activities. So far, women have only been seen in domestic job roles within the family. Dasa Wisma is the smallest group of the Family Welfare Empowerment (PKK) organization which is one of the social groups of local community organizations in every village or kelurahan as a place or forum for education and empowerment of every member of the community, especially women.

Based on observations made by researchers during observations in March 2021 in Gunung Pagat Hamlet, Loa Janan Ulu Village, Loa Janan District, Kutai Kartanegara Regency, the role of Dasa Wisma in shaping the character of social

care for Dasa Wisma members has been very good and active. The character of social concern shown by members of the Dasa Wisma group towards the welfare conditions of the surrounding community, especially families, is very good, they also play a role and are actively involved in every activity organized by Dasa Wisma. Based on the description of the good background above, the author is interested in researching with the title "The Role of Dasa Wisma in Shaping the Character of Social Concern for Dasa Wisma Members in Gunung Pagat Hamlet, Loa Janan Ulu Village, Loa Janan District, Kutai Kartanegara Regency".

II. METHODS

1. The role of Dasa Wisma in shaping the character of social care for Dasa

The results of the study in Gunung Pagat Hamlet, Loa Janan Ulu Village, The role of Dasa Wisma in recording and reporting data on residents and community activities, namely the Dasa Wisma Naga 1 group in recording citizen data, usually to record data on the number of residents, the head of the Dasa Wisma group told the secretary to collect family cards belonging to residents while in recording other citizen data such as data on the number of pregnant women, mothers giving birth, puerperium, birth of babies, death of babies and toddlers and other data usually the

chairman and secretary of the Dasa Wisma group hold visits to residents' homes and ask for family data, the recording of citizen data includes recording the number of families, pregnant women, childbirth mothers, puerperium, mothers dying, babies born, babies dying and deaths of toddlers. Meanwhile, the recording of residents' activities includes recording mutual aid activities and devotional work such as cleaning the surrounding environment, preserving the environment by planting trees, vegetables, programs to build waste facilities by utilizing household waste by making creations from waste and used goods carried out by Dasa Wisma mothers as well as training on creativity development for each individual. The results of the recording of citizen data and citizen activities are then reported to the PKK organization at the level above it to the pkk organization at the sub-district level.

Based on the explanation above, it can be concluded that the role of Dasa Wisma Naga 1 in recording and reporting citizen data and citizen activities has been carried out regularly, citizen data recording activities carried out by the Dasa Wisma Naga 1 group such as collecting family cards belonging to residents and by visiting residents' homes, this can be seen from the completeness of data owned by Dasa Wisma Naga 1 from data on the number of pregnant women, childbirth mothers, breastfeeding mothers, the number of babies and toddlers is complete and the Dasa Wisma Naga 1 group has also recorded all residents' activities by recording, absenteeism and documentation, recorded activities such as siskamling activities, devotional work cleaning the surrounding environment, gardening, posyandu and other community activities.

b. Managing and organizing activities of 10 main PKK programs

Dasa Wisma is the smallest group of the Family Empowerment and Welfare (PKK) organization consisting of 10-20 adjacent houses. As the smallest group of pkk organizations, Dasa Wisma has a very important role in managing and organizing the activities of the 10 main PKK programs, the form of activities such as carrying out arisan activities, mutual cooperation cleaning the surrounding environment, carrying out reading corner activities, UP2K activities with various kinds of businesses and other activities. From the results of research in Dasa Wisma Naga 1 Gunung Pagat Hamlet, Loa Janan Ulu Village, in the Dasa Wisma group, members of the Dasa Wisma group are always fostered and invited to be able to

play an active role in carrying out activities to manage and organize activities of 10 pkk main programs properly, such as being actively involved in carrying out mutual aid activities to clean the surrounding environment, carrying out activities to use land by gardening, farming, raising livestock, carrying out UP2K activities as an effort to improve the family economy, carrying out reading corner activities, carrying out activities related to creativity such as carrying out activities to recycle waste and used goods and other activities.

With the role of Dasa Wisma in managing and organizing activities of 10 pkk main programs. Dasa Wisma members are always given guidance and invitations to be able to play an active role in carrying out activities to manage and organize activities of 10 pkk main programs such as holding arisan activities, mutual cooperation to clean the surrounding environment, carry out land use activities by gardening, farming, raising livestock, carrying out UP2K activities as an effort to improve the family economy, carrying out reading corner activities, carrying out activities related to creativity such as carrying out activities to recycle waste and used goods and other activities.

 The efforts made by Dasa Wisma in shaping the character of social concern for Dasa Wisma members in Loa Janan Ulu Village, Loa Janan District, Kutai Kartanegara Regency

a. Extension

Dasa Wisma Naga 1 Dusun Gunung Pagat Loa Janan Ulu Village, as an effort by Dasa Wisma in shaping the character of social care for Dasa Wisma members by providing counseling to Dasa Wisma members by providing counseling. Counseling as a behavior change process activity that concerns aspects of knowledge and skills and mental attitudes (Anandar & Wibowo, 2015). Counseling as part of Non-formal Education in order to improve the knowledge and skills of the community. Learning is intended to provide learning experiences to target communities, especially women, for the improvement of knowledge and skills.

Based on the explanation above, it can be concluded that the counseling carried out in Dasa Wisma to Dasa Wisma members has gone well, the counseling carried out by Dasa Wisma such as providing counseling on health, members of the Dasa Wisma group are given teaching, direction and motivation in order to play an active role in participating in every activity organized by Dasa Wisma as an effort to succeed the pkk main program and village program.

b. Coaching

One of the objectives of fostering the character of social concern is to form a nation that is resilient, competitive, has a noble character, is moral, tolerant, cooperative, patriotic in spirit, dynamically developing, science and technology-oriented, all of which are imbued with faith and piety in God Almighty. In shaping the character of social care for members of the Dasa Wisma group, the guidance carried out in the Dasa Wisma group is like providing teaching, being given guidance, given directions.

In addition, it also provides training in implementing the main PKK programs implemented by Dasa Wisma such as in carrying out land use activities by gardening, farming, raising livestock such as raising chickens and other activities. The training process is a process in improving special skills to the target participants of the training program (Lukman, 2021b; Riyadi, 2020). Training is also an effort in order to develop yourself in a better direction (Dewi, 2020). Training given to program targets as a form of productivity coaching to be able to develop the potential in individuals or groups (Mustangin et al., 2021). Knowledge and skills will make people able to meet needs, especially needs related to expertise (Monika, 2020). Training as a way to empower the community. So that people have the awareness to continue to learn to improve themselves (Amaliah, 2020). So that people have the confidence to change for the better (Octavia, 2020). This

makes people have good quality to be able to face global competition (Safitri, 2020).

In shaping the character of social care for dasa Wisma Perlu members, it is programmed, either the coaching carried out by the PKK organization or by the Dasa Wisma group itself. Usually training activities, also encouraged by the village, are usually training held such as gardening training, farming and others. With this activity, it is hoped that members of the dasa wisma understand and have a high social concern character for the welfare conditions of the surrounding community.

Based on the above exposure, it can be concluded that social care is a feeling of responsibility for the difficulties faced by others where a person is encouraged to do something to overcome it. "Social Care" in social life is more strongly interpreted as a person's good behavior towards others around him. Social care starts from the will to "give" not "receive". Social concern is attention to the situation of others, Social care today is not widely practiced by many people.
